Comments The Web Science DTC had its first intake in Oct 2009, but the initial cohort (who were mostly computer science background) mainly followed the syllabus for the existing MSc Web Technology. Only the *Foundations of Web Science* module was created for the new taught Masters.

c) Summary of Significant Personal Achievements in Teaching

I am **Director of the Doctoral Training Centre in Web Science** and co-investigator on the Research Councils UK programme grant of £6M for this. The Centre is training a cohort of 80 students from Sept 2009-2014 to become leaders of the UK's Digital Economy. I provide strategic and organisational leadership for the Centre and hands-on delivery of the taught curriculum and supervision of individual students' masters and doctoral research. I lead and oversee the commissioning, monitoring and evaluation of all aspects of the Centre (marketing, admissions, curriculum development and delivery, training requirements, industry engagement, international liaison, finance, reporting) with a view to establishing its long-term sustainability.

I also manage the **ECS Computing Teaching Laboratory**, with budgetary and day to day responsibility for a range of initiatives that provide students with experience of software environments (from mobile personal devices to the cloud), and running developer activities and hack-a-thons.

I am the **course director** for both the **MSc Web Science** (16 students in 2011/12) and **Web Technology** (50 students in 2011/12). I have overall responsibility for admissions strategy and developing and overseeing the delivery and assessment of the curriculum.

In recognition of my contribution to curriculum innovation I received the **Vice Chancellor's Award for Teaching Excellence** in 2010 for a digitally enabled split-site international lecture with an interactive panel of experts at the WebSci2010 conference in Athens.

I have recently initiated **Computing for Teachers** – a series of workshops involving 50 secondary and primary teachers in Hampshire schools to promote the development of Computer Science and programming skills in the curriculum.

I am managing the team that is designing and delivering a new PGCert course for the Open Data Institute, together with associated industry training.

8. Research and Scholarship

a) Summary of current research and scholarship

My current research activity is focused on Web Science, extending its insights to develop theoretical perspectives on the phenomena of open access, open data and the new knowledge sharing activities that the Web affords [1, 5, 6, 13, 167].

b) Summary of research and scholarship in the previous three years

My recent research activity has been directed towards extending the capabilities of research repositories [3, 4, 9, 11, 15, 19, 20, 21, 25, 26, 120, 190, 191], including preservation techniques [8, 17, 178] and novel bibliometrics and impact measures [12, 14]. I have been evaluating the success of the mandates that underpin Open Access [2, 119]. In addition I have been developing an interdisciplinary social-technical (Web Science) perspective of the Web and its growth [7, 22, 24, 118, 166, 167, 168, 169].

c) Summary of significant personal achievements in research and scholarship

I have secured major competitive research grants of £2.0M since 2008, in addition to £6m from the Web Science DTC. I am a strong REF returner with a GPA of 3.0 and I am author of REF Impact Case Study UoA 23 "Open Access and Digital Archiving". On the 196 publications I have authored, I have 1801 citations and an h-index of 23 as determined by Google Scholar (1423 and 19 respectively, according to Microsoft Academic Search).

My doctoral research on the *Distributed Link Service* resulted in a significant number of high quality peer review publications in the area of Open Hypermedia and the Web

- My work led to a patent application and two commercial products (*WebCosm* and *Portal Maximizer*) from Active Navigation Ltd.

Applying the *Distributed Link Service* to collections of scholarly materials in the *Open Journals* and *OpCit* projects led to the development of *EPrints* software and the concept of the institutional repository to support the emerging Open Access agenda.

- I lead the EPrints repository team, which designed and produced the world's first (2000) open access institutional repository software platform, supporting and promoting the development of EPrints.
- EPrints is used by over 400 institutions internationally
- EPrints has been used as a research platform for 25 funded projects in research infrastructure, scientific communication and digital preservation

Subsequent research was undertaken to extend the capabilities of repositories (digital preservation, e-research, e-learning and research management) and to monitor and evaluate the takeup of Open Access practice across the academic community, along with Open Data and Open Educational Resources. This has included developing further systems to support pioneering research on

- systems to provide, monitor and leverage open information
 - Registry of Open Access Repositories (ROAR.eprints.org) a service that monitors the takeup of Open Access practice across the world
- effective policies and practice that best encourage open information
 - Registry of Open Access Repositories Mandatory Archiving Policies (ROARMAP.eprints.org,) a service that monitors the 130+ institutional and 50+ funder Open Access policies
- analysis of the impact of open information through bibliometrics and other online metrics
 - Citebase, a citation-ranked search engine operating on the hundreds of thousands of papers in arxiv.org, the Physics research repository
- I am the **director of EPrints Services**, a commercial spinoff company embedded in the University employing seven people and offering Open Access hosting services, training and support to the research industry. EPrints Services currently hosts open access

repositories for 34 organisations including UK research councils, government agencies and a large pharma and provides open access repository support contracts to 70 organisations, with a turnover of £1 m.

- I am *co-chair of the Scholarly International Infrastructure Technical Summit (SIITS)*, in which role I help to set the international agenda for repository research and development.
- I have chaired major international conferences in this research area, including the Open Repositories in March 2008 (500 delegates) and also the International World Wide Web conference in 2006 (1,000 delegates), and frequently serve on the scientific committees for national and international conferences and symposia.

Accounting for the progress (or lack of it) in Open Access demonstrates that engineering technical systems does not tell the whole story of the impact of ICT. Current research is using Web Science to develop theory and analytical techniques to understand the complex interaction between the technical advantages of web-based repositories and the social constraints of the professional practice of research communication.

- I am a *Fellow of the Web Science Research Initiative and the Southampton University Lab Director* for WSTNet (the Web Science Trust Network of Laboratories, an international organisation of 13 research laboratories that promote and co-operate on the study of Web Science), with responsibility for co-ordinating the international activities of the Southampton lab.
